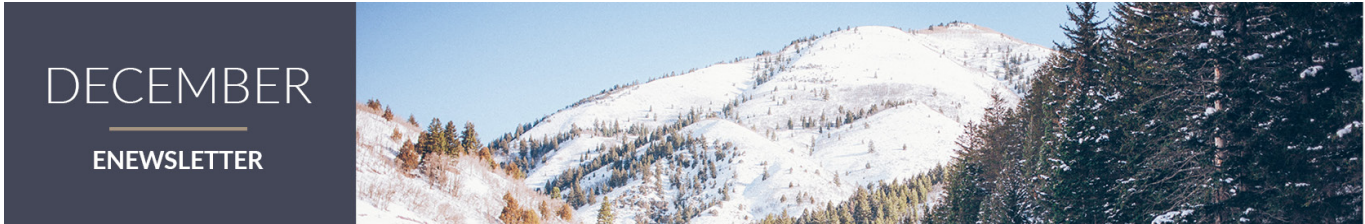

FOUNDATION COMMUNITY FUNDS AWARD \$155,270 TO AREA NONPROFITS

The Community Foundation of Northern Colorado offers monetary support to nonprofits and charitable projects through grant and program distributions. It has local fund committees that review nonprofit applications and select award recipients in their respective communities.

The Berthoud Community Fund Committee awarded \$43,620 to 14 nonprofits, the Estes Valley Community Fund Committee awarded \$92,050 to 22 projects, and Loveland Generations, a giving group celebrating its 20th anniversary, awarded \$19,600 to six organizations. (Click on links to see details.)
